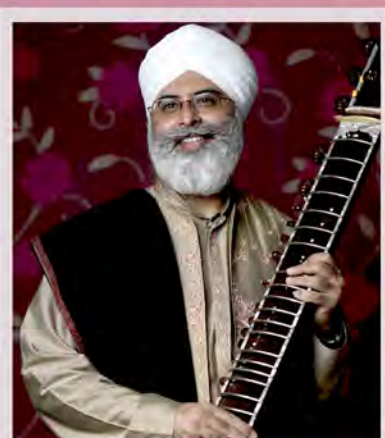
Adults and children of all abilities are welcome and no previous experience in Indian music required!

Instrument hire available, bursaries available, daily Indian vegetarian lunch included.

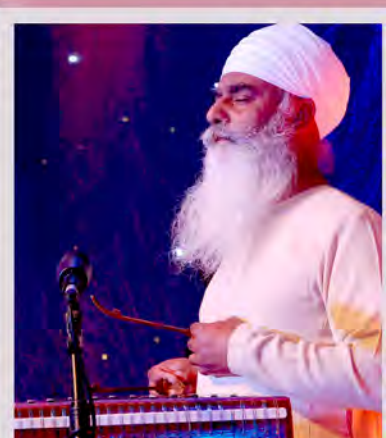
Now introducing an Early years offer for 4-8yrs; a fun week and introduction to Indian music alongside arts and crafts, outdoor activity and games!

Terms and Conditions of Registration to SAA-uk Summer School

1. Agreement

3. Insurance

Except where required by the terms of its own insurance cover, SAA-uk does not accept liability for damages, injuries, illnesses or other claims related to students unless such liability is legally imposed.

4. Medical

The Medical and Dietary information allows you to give us an insight in to your child's health and dietary needs, but we can take no responsibility for any aspects not included. Please give a full account in writing if there are any additional concerns or matters which we should know about.

5. Ability or Disability

To ensure we provide the most suitable support for your child while at SAA-uk Summer School, please provide us with details of any support needs or learning requirements for your child that you feel are relevant to their time at SAA-uk Summer School. Eg mild dyslexia, hearing loss, downs syndrome. If your child is disabled, SAA-uk asks that a carer or family member to be present throughout the week to support the child as SAA-uk Tutors are not responsible for providing specialist SEN support.

6. Changes to the programme

The course has been planned and published in good faith. SAA-uk reserves the right, however, to make any alterations to the programme if deemed necessary.

7. Force Majeure
